

LOTS OF MEDALS, CERTIFICATES, TROPHIES ARE UP FOR GRABS. FIRST ONE IS FOR BEST PRESENTED MALE AND BEST PRESENTED FEMALE. THEN ON WITH THE SKILLS GAMES WHICH INCLUDE: POISON BALL, TAIL GRAB, UNDERS & OVERS, GLOVE CHASE, BELT TYING, BREAKFALL COMPETITION, SPEED THROWING.

Divisions are made according to: number of nominations, weight, age, rank and ability. Bambinos from U5yrs of age and around 20kgs, to Sumos who are the big guns!

Have a day (long day but only once a year) of fun and competition. We are all giving of our time so your children can have a fun Jujitsu day and come away with a medal at least. \$25 for a full day of fun is good value!

Don't be shy! Any parents who are worried, please don't, as we do look after the kids, and to us SAFETY is paramount. Talk to your Sempai, Sensei or even Shihan who will allay your fears.

The Jujitsu competition is fought in three (3) areas:

- 1. Standing where they use throws and takedowns;
- Sparring where they use kicks, punches, blocks. The competitors are dressed in sparring vests, helmet and gloves, 2. which are provided, and face and groin are protected and out of bounds. Mouthguards are not compulsory, but are strongly advised;
- 3. Grappling or groundwork, where holdings, armlocks, strangles, headlocks, leglocks are all used with strong awareness from the referee. If e.g. a strangle is being applied, the referee will call it, if the competitor is not tapping.

Rules will be sent out to everyone closer to the day. Volunteers are being called for now!! Admin tables, timekeepers, scorers, set up personnel, pull down personnel, canteen workers, belt stewards, marshalls, sparring dressing, first aid, emcees, etc. Please put your name down to volunteer and make it a stressless day for all.

Nominate at your dojo to the Sempai who takes the fees! Forms at each dojo!!


